The WFS is currently developing a mobility strategy and operating procedures. It wishes to make Programme accessible to all interested parties and make both the School and students benefit from mobility experience. In 2015 WTS implemented an international studies programme, which turned out to be very popular among foreign students and consequently convinced us to further expand our horizons. Erasmus + will be a key factor for the WFS's internalization programme. The WFS is focused on providing the highest quality of learning experience, sharing practical knowledge and preparing students for all aspects of work in creative industries. All programmes offered by WFS are regularly reviewed and updated, therefore responsive to changes in the dynamic production environment. We are continually looking to raise the level of our position in the international filmmaking stage thanks to our rapid development and creativity.

The WFS wishes to establish long-term cooperation with potential partners sharing the same idea of providing education and within similar specialization.
